DOGS AGES APPROXIMATELY 7 TIMES FASTER THAN HUMANS

If your dog has any of the following symptoms, talk with your vet.



TEETH & GUMS

Smelly breathe, pain, or chewing, preference for wet food, drooling

EYES

Grey, blue or white in the center of the eye, excessive rubbing, redness, lack of tears or thick discharge

LUMPS & BUMPS

Any lumps found on or under the skin

JOINTS

Reluctant to walk, being lame, changes in mobility, difficulties in jumping up or down
